

Norwalk Parks & Rec | American Red Cross Lifeguard Training & Deep Water Recertification



To Qualify: Candidates must register and pass both prerequisite events with no more than two attempts. <u>Event one</u> is a sequence: 150-yard swim – 2-minute tread (only legs) – 50 yd swim. <u>Event two</u> is a timed 20-yard swim, 10-pound item retrieval (deep end of the Competition Pool) with an additional swim using only the legs (maintaining hands on object). Must be able to exit from the side of the pool. Unsuccessful candidates will be dismissed; Candidates will not be taught on site. Practice is encouraged prior to attempt.

[Blended] Lifeguard Course Information

- +15 years old by the final scheduled session date
- All new candidates must pass a prerequisite scheduled AT LEAST one week prior to their course to ensure successful completion of online modules prior to first in-person course. The online session has 16 modules (~6 hours to complete)
- Must attend all session times/dates as listed below.

Recertification Training Info (Instructor Led)

- Participants must hold a current certification, or expired by no more than 30 days (ARC training that included deep water 7 feet or deeper)
- Participates must complete a prerequisite on or before their first scheduled class day.
- Register at the front desk and coordinate a time with the lifeguard instructor prior to session for day-of prerequisites. Completion is required to participate in session.
- Must attend all session times/dates as listed below.



Lifeguard Training & Deep Water Recertification



- New Lifeguards: the blue rounded shape (left side on front page) lists three blended courses for new lifeguards.
- Recertification: the red box (right side of front page) offers two courses for current lifeguard recertifications.
- **These are not introductory course:** Swimming competency and endurance are expected and required to ensure participants can endure the session duration.
- Resting between consecutive laps, touching the ground or holding onto sides during events is unacceptable.
- Contacts or glasses are permitted throughout the session. Unless otherwise noted, goggles are not permitted.
- **About Prerequisite 1:** Swim 150 yards continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing. Candidates may swim using the front crawl (freestyle), breaststroke, or a combination of both but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Candidates will stop at the deepest point of the pool (11 ft 6 in) and maintain position at the surface of the water for 2 minutes by treading while only using the legs. Then candidates will swim an additional 50 yards with the same requirements as before. <u>Goggles are permitted during this event.</u>
- About Prerequisite 2: Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds. Participants will swim 20 yards, surface dive to the deepest point (11 ft 6 in) of pool and retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim back to the starting point on the back using only the legs to kick. Hands must remain on the object. Exit the water using the side of the pool. Goggles are not permitted during this event.
